
## How to Playback Recording in DVR?

We can check previous recording of DVR through DVR direct interface (GUI).

▶ Go for Main Menu  $\rightarrow$  Playback (option in Operation Tab).

- Usually there are three file types:
  - R: Regular recording file.
  - A: External alarm recording file.
  - M: Motion detection recording file

- Section 1: Display Window
  - a. Here is to display the searched picture or file.
  - b. Support 1/4/9/16-window playback.

## Section 2: Calendar -

- a. The Red highlighted date means there is picture or file. Otherwise, there is no picture or file.
- b. In any play mode, click the date you want to see, you can see the corresponding record file trace in the time bar.

- Section 3: Channel Selection
  - a. Select the channel for which user want to check playback. No. of channel to select may vary due to different model.
  - b. The time bar will change once user select the channels.
- Section 4: Playback control
  - a. Please refer to below sheet for more Details -

- Section 5: File List
  - a. The file list is to display the first channel of the record file. As seen in below image.
  - b. Double click on file to start playback.
  - c. User can also search the file as per selected time.

- Section 6: Time Bar
  - a. It is to display the record type and its period in current search criteria.
  - b. In 4-window playback mode, there are corresponding four time bars. In other playback mode, there is only one time bar.
  - c. Use the mouse to click one point of the color zone in the time bar, system begins playback.
  - d. The time bar is beginning with 0 o'clock when you are setting the configuration. The time bar zooms in the period of the current playback time when you are playing the file.
  - e. The green color stands for the regular record file. The red color stands for the external alarm record file. The yellow stands for the motion detect record file.
- Section 7: Record type and Synchronize
  - a. In any play mode, the time bar will change once you modify the search type.
  - b. While playing the file, select sync mode, system can switch to the same period of the corresponding channel to play.
- Section 8: Time Bar Unit
  - a. The option includes: 24Hr, 12Hr, 1Hr and 30Min. The smaller the unit, the larger the zoom rate. You can accurately set the time in the time bar to playback the record.
  - b. The time bar is beginning with 0 o'clock when you are setting the configuration. The time bar zooms in the period of the current playback time when you are playing the file.
